

Cashier Instructions for Summer feeding Program

The cashier will go into serving meals just like always to the meal serving screen (**FS-02-01**), but will select meal type **F** for breakfast meal, **Q** for snack meal, or **M** for lunch meal. When the clerk selects one of the before mentioned meal types it will allow the clerk to serve a reimbursable meal to anyone by simply pressing the **"S"** key at STUDENT ID: ***** prompt on the meal serving screen. The **"S"** key (under the Summer Feeding Program) will be use a generic account and allow the clerk to serve multiple meals as shown on the screen below. . You can also use the **"A"** key to serve adults that could be a part of the program in some instances. You will use the **"V"** key to serve any other adults that are not staff that may participate in the program. You will then press the F1 function key once the cursor is on line 01 that will serve the correct meal and price to the person you selected.
